1. The contracting parties* are obliged to observe all the governing legal provisions and regulations concerning environmental protection, including the regulations of the European Union.
2. The contracting parties should strive at minimisation of the adverse environmental impact of the activity pursued by them at every stage of product life.
3. The contracting parties should strive at reduction of consumption of raw materials and resources, and also at minimisation of waste and pollution generated in the scope of pursued activity.
4. The materials and products delivered to GOLDBECK Prefab Elements by suppliers may not contain any substances or materials banned by the legal provisions or other regulations in force in Poland in the European Union.
5. The obligation of the contracting parties is to ensure that means of transport are maintained in good technical condition and meet the governing emission standards. In case of breakdown of the means of transport of the contracting parties (e.g. leakage of oil or other chemical agent) on the area of GOLDBECK Prefab Elements, the contracting parties or an entity operating on their behalf should be prepared to immediate counteraction and elimination of the results of such a breakdown. They are also obliged to notify without delay an employee of GOLDBECK Prefab Elements of this occurrence and to follow his orders in the scope of actions for the purpose of reduction/elimination of the threat to environment/safety that occurred.
6. The contracting parties are obliged to immediate notification of the representative of GOLDBECK Prefab Elements company on possible occurrence of a breakdown or a near-miss incident on the area of the plant of GOLDBECK Prefab Elements.
7. The contracting parties who use chemical substances or mixtures for service/work performed on the area of GOLDBECK Prefab Elements, are obliged to, in particular, to:
 - a. Store the applied chemical substances or mixtures correctly.
 - b. Adequately organise and secure the place of performance of works, e.g. by using spillage containers when it is recommended.
 - c. Use appropriate personal protective equipment.
 - d. Act in conformity with the instructions included in their material safety data sheets.
8. Waste generated in the course of works on the area of the plant should be collected and accepted in a selective way and pursuant to the laws in force. Waste generated by the

contracting parties (other than municipal waste) belong to their scope of responsibility and are collected by them, unless the contract stipulates otherwise.

9. The contracting parties are obliged to deliver a material safety data sheet of a chemical substance or mixture in Polish language, according to the governing provisions of REACH Regulation at the stage of request for quotation.
10. The contracting parties are obliged to mark packaging with a chemical substance or mixture with a label in Polish language, pursuant to the governing provisions, including CLP Regulation.
11. The contracting parties of GOLDBECK Prefab Elements should promote development and implementation of technologies that impact limitation of the emission of carbon dioxide and reduction of energy consumption, as well as apply logistic solutions with maximally limited adverse environmental impact.
12. Bearing in mind the above, the company GOLDBECK Prefab Elements also encourages every contracting party to implement the Environmental Management System, pursuant to the requirements of the standard ISO 14001.
